




# **How to Cosign a Transaction**

Once a client has created and signed a transaction you will be notified, and the transaction will be available for you to cosign.

**Step 1:** Navigate to the withdrawals page. There you will be able to see all withdrawal requests and filter by "Pending". Click on the three dots in the right-most column of the relevant transaction. This will open a menu where you can sign or cancel the transaction. Click "Sign".

**Step 2:** A “Withdrawal Transaction” pop up will appear where you can confirm the transaction details. With your hardware device ready, click “SIGN” and follow the prompts to cosign the transaction.

**LEDGER USERS NOTE:** Ledger will warn you that the derivation path is unusual, but this is normal, you may continue.
